This funding will be used to


- Support Eatons Hill State School to provide pedagogical and curriculum leadership for the Learning area of English.

They form part of the school's commitment to school improvement through the domains of Systematic Curriculum Delivery, Expert Teaching Teams, Effective Pedagogical Practices and Differentiated Teaching and Learning.

Our Initiatives include


- Supplement the allocation of Support Teacher Literacy and Numeracy.

- Provide teacher release to build capability in Australian Curriculum: English, collaborative planning sessions and data-informed discussions to enhance student learning.

Employ STLaN (1.2 FTE Terms 2-4)	\$122 110
Employ Teacher Aides (41.75hrs per week)	\$ 74 300
Teacher release (TRS): Equivalent of 1 day per term for collaborative planning and case management for class teachers and half day per term for specialist teachers	\$ 94 080
Teacher release time (TRS): Half day per semester to build AC English capability	\$ 21 600
