

Eatons Hill State School Learning Expectations For iPads

All students using iPads to support their learning are required to comply with the following expectations regarding their use.

At home

- Ensure you bring your iPad to school each day fully charged.
- iPads should be stored safely in school bags when going to and from school.

During Lessons

- Follow the 'Apples Up' command by turning your iPad upside down, hands off and looking at your teacher immediately.
- Always ask someone's permission before taking their photo.
- Ensure you are always acting safely with your iPad by holding it with two hands, placing it on a table, keeping the case on and walking, not running with your iPad.
- Only open an App once your teacher has instructed you.
- Only use the Apps identified as 'School Apps' (no 'Home Apps').
- Communicating with other students, using your device, during learning time is not permitted unless under direct instruction from your teacher.
- Mirror your own device only when instructed by the teacher.
- Do not touch or take any other student's iPad or iPad belongings e.g. headphones.
- Focus on the task when completing activities on your iPad.

Communicating with others

- Respectful communication should be used at all times, either on the iPad or when using other communication methods e.g. email.
- Students have been supplied with an EQ email address. This must be the only email used between students, teachers and other students when communicating or transferring documents.

Use iPads in and around the school

- While at school, iPads are to be used for educational purposes only. This includes the use of camera and video devices. The use of these devices is only permitted under teacher direction.
- To avoid damage, food and drinks should be kept away from iPads.
- Your iPad is for your use only. Do not share it with others.
- If you need a passcode on your iPad your teacher will share a class passcode for you to use. You cannot have a personal passcode on your iPad as teachers, the tech team, deputies and principals may need to access your iPad.

Cyber safety and security

- Ensure you are cyber safe by keeping your personal details, including username, password, address or phone number private.
- Your account details need to be kept private. It is not appropriate to share these details with another student for their use.
- Do not publish anything mean, nasty or disrespectful about a teacher or other students.
- Do not be a bystander to cyberbullying. Always tell an adult if you have any concerns that you or someone else is being bullied.
